# **Qualifications:**

- Must have mature characteristics and be extremely dependable and reliable.
- Tribal Preference applies.
- High School diploma, HSED, GED is required.
- Must possess Associate's degree (A.A. or equivalent from two-year or technical school; or have obtained six months to one-year related experience and or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Ability to establish and maintain productive working relationships with staff, clients, also representatives to effectively carry out duties as required.
- Must possess a valid driver's license, reliable transportation and be willing to travel to various sites.
- Must be able to pass a background check.
- Must be able to pass a pre-employment drug screen.

#### **Duties and responsibilities:**

- Must be able to effectively present information and respond to questions from groups of managers, clients, customers, and the general public.
- Responsible for the overall direction, coordination, and evaluation of the program.
- Responsible for ordering and picking up needed materials.
- While performing duties, willing to be frequently exposed to outside weather conditions and extreme heat. Employees may be occasionally exposed to wet and/or humid conditions, moving mechanical parts, and risk of electrical shock. Noise level in work environment is usually moderate.
